- Sessions and headcount completed to date by Region
 - SSEB – 82 classes with 1,456
 - Midwest – 14 classes with 181 students
 - WGA – 52 classes with 817 students
 - Northeast – 49 classes with 792 students
- ✓ Total students trained to date 3,246

MERRTT Program Revisions

- Approach used same as in the past. Each Regional Group provided one SME to work as a Task Group member to accept/reject the offered comments
- MERRTT – Approximately 50 comments accumulated from course evaluation forms submitted by students and instructors for improving MERRTT



MERRTT Program Revisions

- Revision highlights include:
 1. Updated references/videos to include 2012 ERG
 2. Added additional pictures/graphics of equipment and responses
 3. Streamlined Incident Command Module 15 with Incident Control Module 7 creating additional time
 4. Use the time created by the streamlining to create a Case Histories Module 15
- MERRTT is in final draft and being piloted in several locations over the next couple of months

TEPP Improvement Project

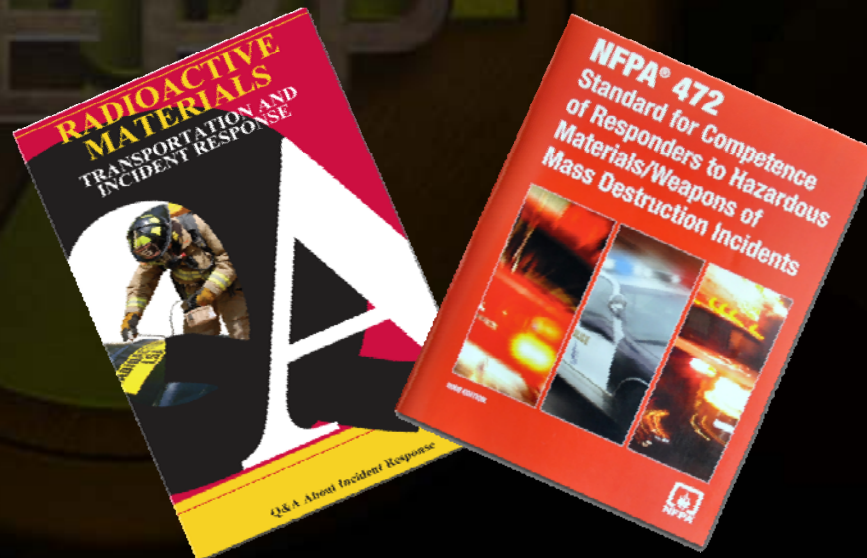
- Develop an Interactive Computer Based Training Program
