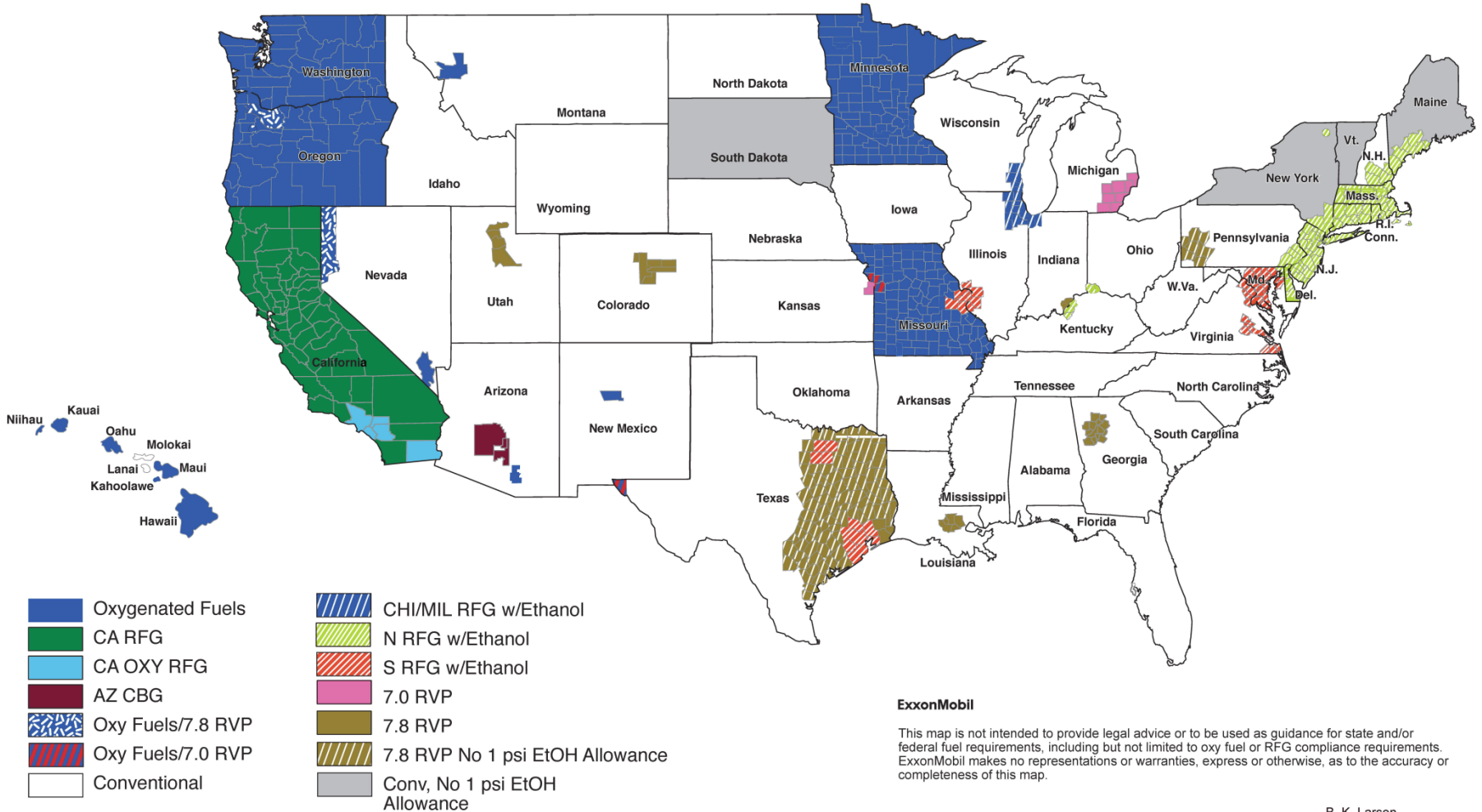


Fuels Regulations – Federal and State

- EPA regulates fuel properties affecting air quality:
 - Tailpipe emissions: Sulfur, Benzene, Lead, etc.
 - Evaporative emissions: Reid Vapor Pressure (RVP) - contributes to ozone formation
 - Vapor pressure is adjusted seasonally for proper vehicle operation
- States primarily regulate for Consumer Protection and Air Quality
 - Many states endorse the NCWM Handbook 130
