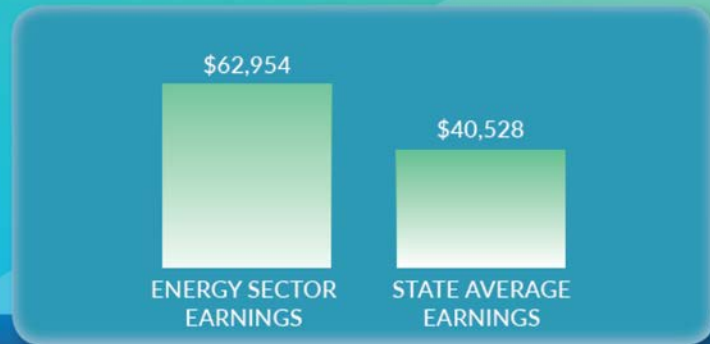

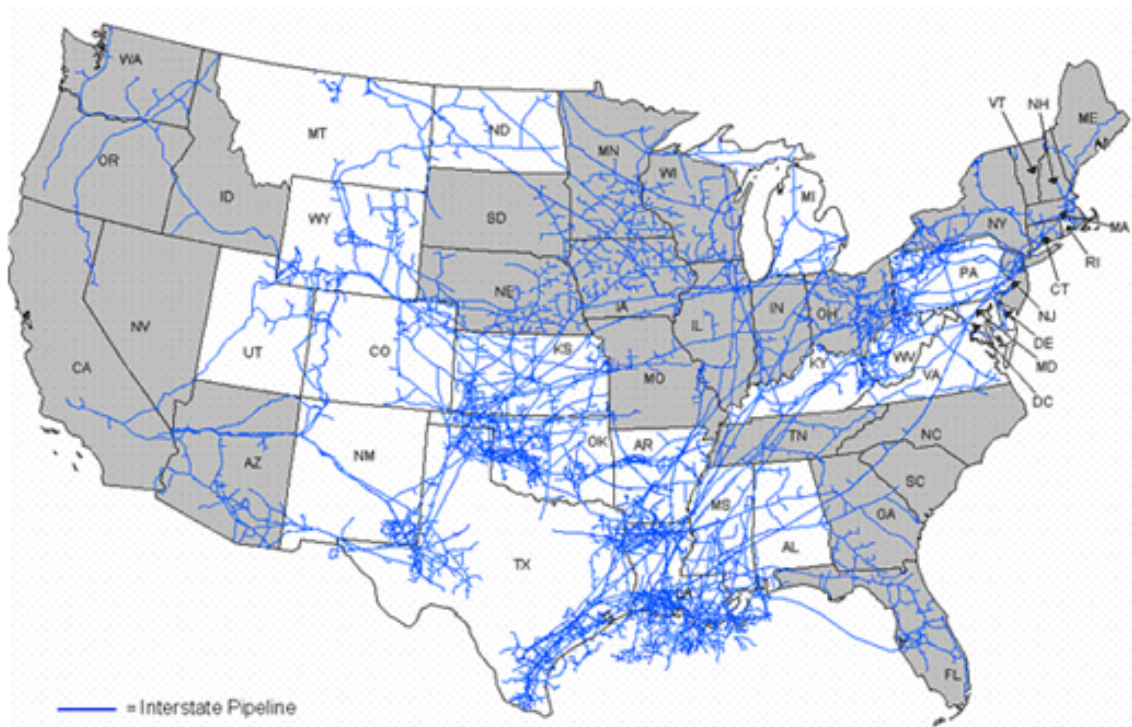

- **Mississippi has 13,000 miles of interstate pipeline and 1,600 gas wells**



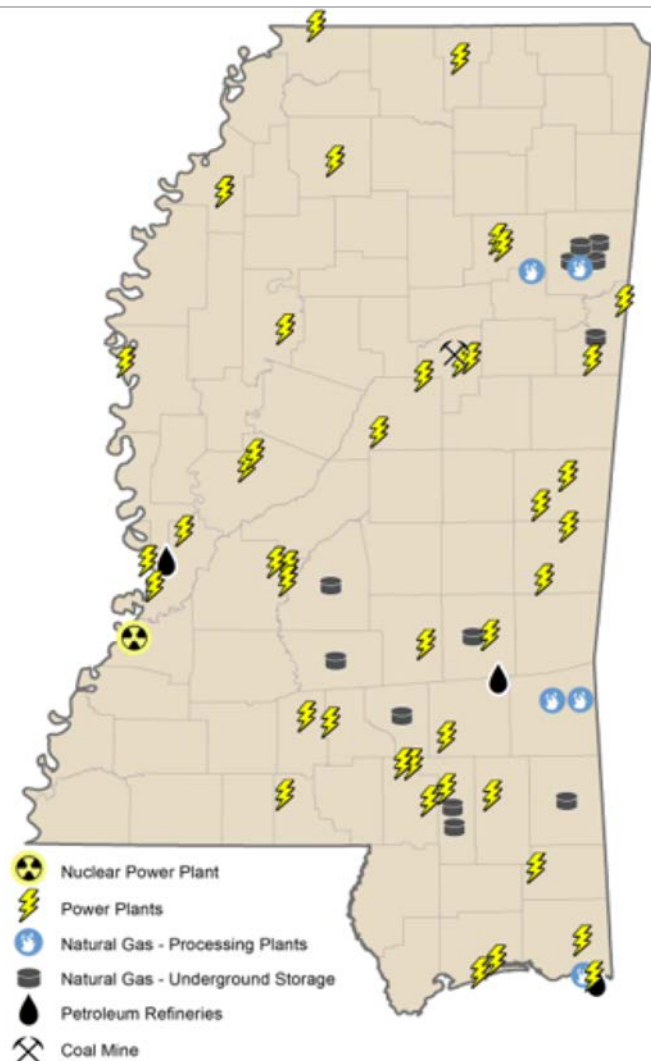
Port of Gulfport
